

40th Kaike Triathlon

Important Points to Consider Before Applying

The below important points concerning the 40th Kaike Triathlon should be carefully read and thoroughly understood before applying to the race.

1. A participant's entry will be rescinded even after receiving notice of selection in either the event that they engage in any actions that violate public order and standards of decency or organizers decide that they are not eligible to compete.

2. Kaike Triathlon is conducted according to the Japan Triathlon Union (JTU) rules as well as the Kaike Triathlon local rules. Participants must carefully read the Triathlon Race Information materials that will be sent to them beforehand and ensure they fully comprehend the Kaike Triathlon rules before participating.

Traffic will not be controlled during the race. Kaike Triathlon participants must follow all traffic rules when competing on public roads

4. Wetsuits are optional for the swimming leg when the water temperature is above 22°C.

5. For safety reasons, there may be changes to the race course depending on road and traffic conditions.

6. According to a revised section of Tottori Prefectural Road Traffic Act's administrative instructions, cyclists are required to install a bicycle bell (warning device).

7. If the race is cancelled due to the reason beyond the control of the organizer, the race entry fee will not be refunded. Also, the race entry fee will not be refunded in the event a participant withdraws after their race number has been decided.

8. Participants should train appropriately, consider receiving a health examination, and otherwise take steps to ensure that they are in good condition before competing.

9. Athletes are responsible for their own safety and need to carry out their own bicycle maintenance.

10. The scope of compensation for accidents that occur during the race will be within the coverage

provided by the accident insurance entered into by the organizer.

11. During the race, event headquarters may recommend and/or order a participant to withdraw from the race regardless of the desires of the affected participant.

12. The organizer retains the right of publicity in relation to the race and may provide participant's information to the media in order to promote the race.
